Through our teaching of PSHE we aim to enable our children to:

- Be aware of safety issues
- Develop good relationships with their peers and those around them

- Develop self-confidence and feel they can make an informed choice

We want children to be active and learn by getting involved in discussions, investigations and drama.

Circle Time is used for PHSE and team building.. It encourages children to listen to each other, discuss ideas and improvements. All children feel valued. Children are allowed to “pass” if they do not wish to comment. Circle Time allows children to feel that their ideas or contributions matter.

Children are encouraged to be independent and also to be able to work collaboratively. They are encouraged to persevere with challenges and think for themselves. The important factor is that children understand that they can learn from mistakes and that effective learning sometimes means you get it wrong.
