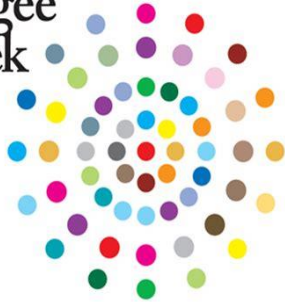

During Refugee Week, our friends at Norwich City of Sanctuary will be projecting a giant image onto the side of the Norwich Castle.

The love heart has been chosen as the logo for a new national campaign 'Together with Refugees' which is being launched this month by a coalition of refugee charities from around the UK, including City of Sanctuary, in response to the government's new Immigration bill.

We are organising a creative show of solidarity, which is being replicated in other cities across the UK, that will be made up of the faces of the people from Norwich and Norfolk, that agree with our statement: agree with our statement: "We want to live in a welcoming city"
