Safeguarding

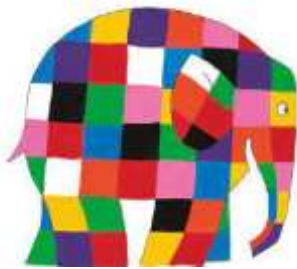
You may be thinking of trying a new enrichment club over the summer holidays. Here is some advice on ensuring that any provision you choose meets safeguarding expectations.
