Key indicator 1: The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity

- Provision of high-quality outdoor equipment to promote free flow active learning throughout the day.
- All Year 2 children to have access to regular swimming lessons in order to feel safe and confident in the water.
- Sports Factory to provide high-quality lunchtime experiences, promoting, being active, turn-taking, teamwork, sportsmanship and appropriate use of space and resources.
- Sports Factory to train Midday Supervisors to lead active games.
- Nurture Lead to provide high quality lunchtime experience, promoting appropriate use of space and resources.

Key indicator 2: The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement

- During sport and PE pupils will experience a variety of different learning spaces such as the hall, field, sports hall and playground, this will offer a range of spaces and surfaces in which to develop a range of physical skills.
- Targeted children funded to access sports clubs for a limited number of sessions therefore increasing their activity levels.
- Through the Bikability scheme pupils will develop confidence to cycle safely, encouraging this as an alternative ways method of travel to school.

Key Indicator 3: Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport

- PE Lead to will continue to participate in ongoing professional development, in order to support staff with developing lessons, assessment and skills.

Key indicator 4: Broader experience of a range of sports and physical activities offered to all pupils

- Provision of sports through external providers, such as karate and tennis taster sessions for all pupils.
